

POLLINATOR GARDEN

BEGINNER'S GUIDE FOR MICHIGAN NATIVE PLANTS

Below is a rough layout for a sunny, pollinator-friendly native pollinator garden that anyone could grow in their own backyard. This lot is approximately 3'-4' wide and 7'-10' long but can be scaled to fit your available space. You can also experiment with the number of plants that you plant.

June-August

3'- 6' tall
Sept-Oct



MARSH BLAZING STAR

Liatris spicata
Pink
3'- 4' tall
July-August



WILD COLUMBINE

Aquilegia canadensis
Red
1'- 3' tall
May-July



BEARDTONGUE

Penstemon digitalis
White
3'- 4' tall
June-July



PURPLE CONEFLOWER

Echinacea Purpurea
Pink
3'- 4' tall
June-August



BLACK-EYED SUSANS

Rudbeckia hirta
Yellow
1'- 3' tall
June-Sept
